## Biographical Sketch

Sergeant First Class Larry D. Miller is an Airborne Ranger serving as a Competitor on the Formation Free Fall Team.

Miller entered the Army in February 1999 and after completion of his initial entry training he was assigned to Alpha Company 2nd Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment, Fort Lewis, WA, 1999 through 2001.

In September 2001 he attended the Golden Knight Assessment and Selection Program and upon completion Miller was assigned to the Black Demonstration Team for one year. He then worked in operations as the Formation Freefall Team Coordinator for a year, five years as a Free Fall Competition Cameraman and seven years in a competition slot.

Miller with his Team, has won two Gold Medals in Women's Four way at the 2004/2006 Military World Meet. At the 2004 Nationals he earned three silver medals in Four way, Eight way and 16 way and a Gold Medal in 10 way



formation freefall. At the 2005 Nationals he earned two Silvers in Four way and Eight way, a Gold Medal in 10-way and a Bronze Medal in 16 Way. At the 2007 Military World Meet his team earned the Silver Medal in the Four Way, 2008 Silver medals at the U.S. Nationals and World meet. At the 2010 U.S. National Skydiving Championships they brought home one Gold and two Silver Medals. He and his Team also brought back Silver from the World Meet in Menzelinsk, Russia. In 2011 he won four Gold at the U.S. Nationals in Eloy, Arizona, and a Gold Medal at the World Cup in Saarlouis, Germany. He and his Team brought back Gold from the 2012 World Skydiving Championships in Dubai, United Arab Emirates. In 2013 they won three Gold and the overall Medal at the U.S. Nationals.

His most recent accomplishments include winning three Gold and the Overall Medal at the U.S. Nationals at Chicago, IL and a Gold Medal from the World Skydiving Championships in the Czech Republic of 2014.

In his free time Miller enjoys, working with computers and spending time with family.
